- a) Looking back at this passage, was there anything you heard for the first time or something that caught your attention, challenged you, or encouraged you?
- b) In what areas (verses 3–4) are you most tempted to walk in ways that are not **loving** to others? On the other hand, what are some things for which you are thankful? Express your thanks to God.
- c) In order to walk in **light**, we are called towards goodness, righteousness, and truth (verse 9). Which of these three areas most resonate with you? Why?
- d) Paul says, “Be very careful” as we walk in **wisdom** (v. 15). How can we take care of our Christian life? What are the characteristics of a wise person according to verses 15–17?
