Weekday Application Questions

I. EQUIP — Read the following proposal to our doctrinal statement and study the supporting Scriptures: “The Father. We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all things, visible and invisible. We believe that the Father is the sovereign Ruler and Judge over all things who also loves and cares for all aspects of His creation. We believe that He is the Reconciler of all who come to Him through faith in His Son, Jesus Christ. We believe that He is infinitely holy and yet abounding in grace, all-powerful and yet compassionate, perfectly just and yet patiently merciful (Gen. 1:1; Exod. 34:6-7; Matt. 5:45; 6:25-33; John 1.12, 18; Rom. 8.14-17; 1 Cor. 15.24-28; Gal. 4.5; Heb. 12.5-9).”

II. ENGAGE — Think of a popular television show or movie with a main father figure. How is the role of the father portrayed? In what ways are your culture’s views of fatherhood influencing your views of God the Father?

III. EXALT — Which attributes of God the Father from Matthew 6.9-13 stood out to you? Why? How is your worship of the Father improved through these attributes?
